# SCHOOL BOARD MEETING MINUTES Thursday, April 10th, 2025

#### **REVIEW OF CONSENT ITEMS**

The March Minutes and Consent Agenda and items were reviewed prior to the meeting. Kent Lammers asked for a motion to approve the consent items and minutes. This motion was made by Boyd Crockett and seconded by Jane Fairchild. The motion was approved.

### **GUEST PRESENTATION**

Dr. Wanda Miller discussed the school system's mental health services, including therapy, check-ins, and crisis intervention, noting around 100 active clients are being served. She highlighted the success of the intern program and opportunities for future growth.

#### **REPORTS**

#### **Financial Statements:**

- **A.** Margaret Calliotte presented the March statements, detailing cash equivalents and accounts receivable. She presented financials, showing \$4,576,602 in operating cash and \$7,046,572 in total cash and cash equivalents. Kent Lammers asked for a motion to approve March Financial Statements. This motion was made by Fr. Lewis Hejna and seconded by Fr. Tom Kiefer. The motion was approved.
- **B.** Enrollment for the 2025-2026 school year stands at 1,374 students, down 55 from the revised budget (keeping in mind we are still ahead of the previous enrollment window).
- C. Director of Schools: Sr. Cecilia Ann shared several updates including:
- Hiring Process: Still ongoing; overall progress is going well. Continued prayers requested.
- Scholarship Update:129 families awarded scholarships, benefiting 224 students totaling just over \$245,000.
- Employee Appreciation: Central office is providing an appreciation lunch for all school employees over the next couple of weeks.
- Title II & Title IV Applications: Currently preparing applications for next school year and funding allocations are expected in June or July.
- Fifth Grade Retreat: Originally planned in Carthage, but canceled due to weather. Springfield schools are planning a local gathering instead on May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Outreach to St. Joe's is underway to possibly join.
- D. Director of Development: Becky Conroy shared several updates including:
- The Alumni Association hosted March bracket challenge fundraiser.
- The success of Emerald Evening which raised \$693,058, with significant contributions from the auction, 50/50 raffle, and sponsorships. The match for Fund-A-Need was met raising \$383,886 for The Shepherds' Fund. And the 50/50 raffle went to an SCS teacher, Rachel Snodgrass.
- Reminders about Summer Jam at St. Agnes on May 3<sup>rd</sup> and the Open House for Sr. Cecilia Ann at SCHS on May 14, from 4-6:30.
