The presence and use of alcoholic beverages and other drugs seriously threaten the health, safety, and well-being of Springfield Catholic's students and staff; Springfield Catholic High School is committed to promoting and providing a substance-free environment for all students. Hence, under the influence, the use, possession, sale, and transfer of alcohol, drugs, and/or drug paraphernalia, or knowingly associating with those so involved while on the school campus or at any school-related activities in which a student participates (athletic events, field trips, prom, school trips) or in which the student does not directly participate but represents the school or student body simply by being there (ex: spectator at an athletic event or play) are forbidden and result in referral to the administration and may cause immediate suspension and/or expulsion from school.

Because we at Springfield Catholic are concerned with the health and well-being of our student body, we are taking a more proactive stance on substance abuse. I hope you'll join me in creating a safe school environment for all of our students by reading and supporting the procedures below:

- Any student attending the prom may be subject to a random breathalyzer test by local authorities.
- Any senior asked to leave Prom may not be allowed to participate in any of the extra-curricular graduation activities.
- Any student asked to leave Prom due to poor behavior will not be allowed to attend any future Springfield Catholic High School's dances.
- A student bringing a guest from another school will be held responsible for the actions of their guest as well as for their own.
- Please note that the Prom will end at 11:00 p.m. Any student who leaves before this time will sign out, giving the departure time.
- As in the past, students who have been out of school for less than one year are allowed at prom.
- All guests of SCHS students must also sign this form and agree to comply with its regulations.
